**VIDEO/DVD/DIGITAL MEDIA USE**

**EFE (LEGAL/LOCAL)**

Videos/DVDS/Digital Media must be utilized for instructional use with consideration of the following:

- Teachers should maintain professional and responsible judgment in the selection and use of media.
- All media must be previewed by the classroom teacher.
- All media must enhance and support grade-level TEKS and RISD curriculum.
- The instructor should provide pre and post activities.
- All video media must be approved by the campus administrator subject to the following:
  - “G” rating generally acceptable at all levels.
  - PG acceptable with principal approval.
  - PG-13 acceptable only at the secondary level with principal approval.
  - “R” rated videos are not appropriate at any level.
- The campus principal may elect to appoint a peer review committee to preview a questionable media.
- Media containing offensive language, stereotypes, excessive violence or nudity are not allowed.
- All provisions of the United States Copyright Law shall be observed.
- The use of media for entertainment/reward purposes is a copyright violation.
